What impact does the plight of others have on your emotions?

Romans so far.

Romans 1 - 4 ... sin ... alienated from God ... grace ... forgiveness ... eternal life.

Romans 5 - 8 ... what living life as God's people looks like

Romans 9 - 11 ...why God's promises in the Old Testament are still valid

Romans 12 - 16 ... practical view of what a church founded on salvation through Christ and shaped by God's grace should look like.

God's promise

Gen 12:1-3 - "The LORD had said to Abram, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you. 2 "I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

God re-affirms his faithfulness to these promises

Romans 9:4-5... the amazing things God has done for his people.

sorrow and anguish - his people did not believe.
