John 8:12-30 – Never Walk in Darkness

Who is Jesus?

Would the 'Jesus of their answers' match the 'Jesus of reality'?

- The festival of tabernacles.

Jesus' incredible claim

John 8:12, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of light".

- Temple lighting ceremony
- From the OT
 - John 1:5, "The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it."
 - The Messiah's coming.

The Pharisee's reaction

- Mocking
- they lack understanding
- they do not know the Father
- Unable to seize Jesus

The consequences

Verse 21 he says, "I am going away and you will look for me, and you will die in your sin. Where I go you cannot come" (and verse 24)

Another vital clue

(v24) - "I told you that you would die in your sins, if you do not believe that I Am, you will die in your sins". (and v 28)

He uses the name of God for himself (I AM)
