The words of the covenant...

What is a covenant?

1. An initial commitment
2. Changed pattern of behaviour
3. Determination to continue in relationship

Two things on this passage

- It's not just an ancient history lesson

- This is to do with real life, not just 'religious stuff'

“¹² You are standing here in order to enter into a covenant with the Lord your God, a covenant the Lord is making with you this day and sealing with an oath, ¹³ to confirm you this day as his people, that he may be your God as he promised you and as he swore to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.” Deuteronomy 29:12-13

“¹⁹ When such a person hears the words of this oath and they invoke a blessing on themselves, thinking, “I will be safe, even though I persist in going my own way,” they will bring disaster on the watered land as well as the dry. ²⁰ The Lord will never be willing to forgive them; his wrath and zeal will burn against them.” Deuteronomy 29:19-20a
