# The reasons for God's judgement (v6b-8)

- a) Took advantage of the weak, the poor and the vulnerable among them.
- ... denying them any sort of justice.
- ... sexual exploitation.
- b) corrupted their worship of God.

## <u>Israel should have known better</u> (v 9-12)

- ...with their greater privilege comes a greater responsibility.
- a) God has rescued them from Egypt
- b) They have rejected those God has sent to call them back to him.

### God's just punishment (v13-15)

- ...both comprehensive and total.
- ...because of the unjust living and their corrupted worship.

#### For us today

- 1) Listen to God's word
- "Are we people who take listening to God's word seriously?"

#### 2) Our gospel driven care of the vulnerable

#### **Problem**

- ...care for the vulnerable but they end up no longer speaking the gospel
- ... speak the gospel but we must also be people who care for the vulnerable
