Pleasure paradox. "The paradox of hedonism, also called the pleasure paradox, refers to the practical difficulties encountered in the pursuit of pleasure. For the hedonist, constant pleasure-seeking may not yield the most actual pleasure or happiness in the long term—or short term, when consciously pursuing pleasure interferes with experiencing it.

What brings it all undone?

- ... how short and finite life really is
- ... making wise decisions are far better than making foolish decisions.

as light is better than darkness.

His conclusion so far

v 25, satisfaction comes from the hand of God ... for without him who can find enjoyment.

v 26

...a right relationship with God will result in wisdom in how to live life well, understand what life is about and happiness in life.
