What is the value of history?

- Understanding where we're coming from helps us understand where we are and where we're going.
- Paul's Galatian context is that there are "Judaisers" trying to influence the church away from him.
- He tells his story to guide the church towards confidence in the gospel of faith in Christ.

Paul's history Part 1...

- The divine origins of Paul's gospel: the "superjew" transformed by God (1:11-16)
- The unusual response: the convert who didn't need teaching (1:11-24)

Paul's history Part 2...

- Fourteen years later, Paul hits Jerusalem again as tensions mount between Jewish and Gentile populations, inside and outside the church.
- Despite the difficulty and the tension, the church remains unified around salvation by faith in Christ alone. Grace wins the day.

Further discussion

- 1. Does it matter that my/your gospel is not "from God" directly like Paul? Can we ever be as sure as Paul was that we have truth?
- 2. Does someone's pedigree matter in preaching the gospel? Do we really NEED "qualified leaders" or is anyone's interpretation equally valid?
- 3. What actually makes a good Christian? What might we be we adding or subtracting from the requirements of following Jesus?
