1 Peter 3:18 – Christ died for sins once for all the righteous for the unrighteous to bring you to God.

1 Peter 1:3 – Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, in his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead

John 3:36 – Whoever believes in the Son has Eternal life, but whoever reject the Son will not see life for God’s wrath remains on him”
