## 04 – Ezra 3:7-13 – Joy and Sadness

# The story so far

- 1) God's good and perfect creation
- 2) Sadly God's people want to be like God
- 3) Gen 3:15, God promised to fix the problem and reverse the effects of the fall
- 4) Gen 12 ... A promise to Abraham.
- 5) Sadly sin kept its grip on humanity but ... God kept his promises
- 6) People rejected God again
- 7) ...BUT then things got bad ... 722 BC
- 8) God ... sent in the Babylonian army to judge and discipline them ... exile.
- 9) If they repented, a remnant would return to Jerusalem.
- 10)Their hearts are NOW clearly focussed on the right worship of God.

## **Finally work begins**

Ezra 3:8 ... the second month of the second year.

Verse 7 ... the last 7 months.

... the priests are central to the whole project.

Temple workers needed to be clean before God

#### Like the first time

they are building the temple like they did last time.

... as it was first done by God's people and revealed to them by God's word.

## YHWH is praised

verse 11 ... people broke into song praising YHWH

- ... because of what the temple represented for the people.
- YHWH dwelt in their midst.
- The place they could be reconciled to YHWH again.
- YHWH could be praised and celebrated

verse 11, "He is good, his love endures forever".

<u>...as people weep</u> v 12 - 13 ... people also wept.

For us today

The temple today

The temple building and the sacrificial system associated with it has NO bearing on how we worship God today under the New covenant.

John 2:13-23 - Jesus makes a claim about his own body replacing the temple.

John 4:21-24 - the temple in Jerusalem no longer being important for how God is worshipped.

Hebrews 9-13

The story is not yet over

We should be reading Ezra expecting something more.

See Ezekiel 40-44

Hebrews 9:9 ... a shadow of the things to come

Revelation 21:3 ... no temple in heaven because God's dwelling place is now with the people.
