

Serve one another (Team Apple)

Jesus calls us to have a **loving mindset** of humble, servant-hearted love toward others.

1. How did Jesus serve us? Read Mark 10:42-45 and Hebrews 12:2.
2. How are Christians to serve one another? Read Philippians 2:1-11, Ephesians 5:21, Romans 12:2 and 1 Peter 4:8-11.
3. What might hinder us from serving?
4. How have you been served in our church?
5. Discuss some *practical* ways we can serve one another in our church family. Pray for God's help in doing this.

Be ready to share these discoveries about serving one another with the larger group.

Embrace one another (Team Peach)

Jesus calls us to **open loving arms** to welcome and include one another.

1. How does Jesus embrace/welcome us? Read Romans 5:6-11.
2. How are Christians to embrace/welcome one another? Read Matthew 25:31-46, James 2:1, Romans 15:5-7 and 1 Peter 4:8-11.
3. What might hinder us from embracing others?
4. How have you been 'embraced' in our church?
5. Discuss some *practical* ways we can welcome and accept one another in our church family. Pray for God's help in doing this.

Be ready to share these discoveries about embracing one another with the larger group.

Encourage one another (Team Orange)

Jesus calls us to use our mouths to **speak loving words** to one another (teach, encourage, admonish, build up, be honest, be thankful).

1. How does Jesus encourage and teach us? Read John 14:1-7 and Ephesians 4:11-13.
2. How are Christians to encourage one another? Read Hebrews 10:23-25, 1 Thessalonians 5:9-11, Colossians 3:16 and Ephesians 4:29.
3. What might hinder us from encouraging others with God's word?
4. How have you been encouraged by God's word in our church?
5. Discuss some *practical* ways we can encourage one another in our church family. Pray for God's help in doing this.

Be ready to share these discoveries about encouraging one another with the larger group.

Care for one another (Team Plum)

Jesus calls us to use **loving hands and feet** to **practically care for each other**.

1. How does Jesus care for us? Read Matthew 11:28-30 and 1 John 3:16.
2. How are Christians to practically care for one another? Read 1 John 3:16-18, 1 Peter 4:8-11, Galatians 6:2 and Acts 4:32-35.
3. What might hinder us from caring for one another?
4. How have you been cared for in our church?
5. Discuss some *practical* ways we can care for one another in our church family. Pray for God's help in doing this.

Be ready to share these discoveries about caring for one another with the larger group.

Forgive one another (Team Pear)

Jesus calls us to have a **loving heart** to reconcile and live at peace with one another.

1. How does Jesus forgive us? Read 1 John 1:8-2:2.
2. How are Christians to forgive one another? Read Ephesians 4:31-32, Romans 12:14-21, 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 and Matthew 6:14-15.
3. What might hinder us from seeking reconciliation and peace with one another?
4. How have you experienced forgiveness, patience or grace from others at our church?
5. Discuss some *practical* ways we can be patient, grace-filled and seek reconciliation in our church family. Pray for God's help in doing this.

Be ready to share these discoveries about forgiving one another with the larger group.

Pray for one another (Team Apricot)

Jesus calls us to have a **loving spirit** by praying for one another.

1. How does Jesus pray for us? Read John 17:20-24 and Hebrews 7:24-25.
2. How are Christians to pray for one another? Read Colossians 1:9-14, Ephesians 6:18-20 and James 5:13-16.
3. What might hinder us from praying for one another?
4. How have you been prayed for by our church family?
5. Discuss some *practical* ways we can make sure we pray for one another in our church family. Pray for God's help in doing this.

Be ready to share these discoveries about praying for one another with the larger group.
